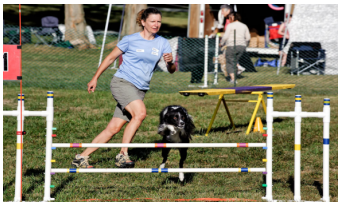

In 2004, Donna left the public school teaching profession to devote her energy and talents to teaching agility. Her students frequently comment that it is this "teaching skill" that makes her a successful instructor. She frequently attends seminars and workshops to keep up-to-date on the latest techniques and has successfully brought those techniques to her students.

Donna has achieved the highest titles in USDAA and AKC agility, and currently competes with Pembroke Welsh Corgis and Border Collies. She has qualified, competed, and reached the finals/challenger rounds at both the AKC and USDAA National Agility Championships. Most recently Donna and her corgi, Lark, made the finals round at the 2014 AKC Nationals that were held in Harrisburg, PA, placing fourth. In 2015 Donna and Lark qualified for and competed at the AKC Invitational in Orlando, FL, as the #2 Pembroke Welsh Corgi. In 2016 she will begin trialing the newest member of the family, border collie, Suzy.



Donna excels at bringing training techniques to her agility students and places emphasis on the handler-dog relationship. She has many students who came out of Novice A/ Starters classes, and are now competing successfully in Excellent/Masters classes. Her students have earned MACH/ADCH titles and have competed at the National level. Many students have trained with her for numerous years and with several generations of their agility partners.
