### **PRE-NOVICE/NOVICE DAY – December 10, 2016 – two half day sessions sign up for one or both**

#### 9:00-12:30 - Developing the Critical Handling Skills

We will discuss and practice several skills and patterns that are commonly seen and used in agility. They will include serpentine, pinwheels, sends, and non-obvious tunnel entrances. NO CONTACT OR WEAVE behavior needed

#### 1:30-5:00 - Course Work

We will work on walking a course and deciding on a plan to successfully and efficiently navigate the course. Courses will include the skills used in the morning session plus contacts and weaves.

### **OPEN/EXCELLENT DAY – December 11 , 2016 8:30 AM – 4:30 PM One full day session**

#### 8:30- 12:00 - Beyond the Basics

We will discuss and practice some of the more advanced skills and patterns seen in agility. They may include 270's, backsides of jumps, threadles/pull throughs, discriminations, and more complicated serpentine.

#### 1:00 – 4:30 Course Work

We will work on courses/sequences to find the most efficient lines for each dog/handler team. Courses will include some of the skills from the morning session.
