

## **DONNA BROWN'S CLASS POLICIES (2016)**

This form must be read, signed, and returned to Donna Brown prior to enrollment in any class that she is teaching in 2016. Only one signed form is needed per year.

1. Dogs are to be under the control of the handler at all times. Dogs are not to be left on an unsecured down-stay while you are walking or at any time during a class. You may not walk a course with a dog. Do not release your dog for its turn in a sequence or run, until the person before you has control of their dog.
2. Dogs and handlers are not permitted to use the equipment without an instructor present and without the permission of the instructor.
3. Dogs should not be barking excessively while we are discussing or walking a course. The only time a dog is permitted to bark is when it is on course. Dogs are also not to lunge at other dogs or people while they are running a course. Ask the instructor for help if these problems occur.
4. All handlers are expected to assist with course and height changes. The only handlers exempt are those that just finished their run or are preparing to be the next dog/handler team on course.
5. Dogs may be dismissed for inappropriate class behavior, such as aggression. No refunds will be given and dismissals are at the discretion of the instructor.
6. Dogs in heat may not attend class. No refunds will be given for a dog in heat, but handlers are encouraged to audit the classes. If you own another dog that is suitable for the class, substitution may be allowed with permission of the instructor. Please bathe your girls before returning to class.
